

Higher Degree Scholarships for 2007

Master of Engineering Science in Pulp and Paper Technology by Coursework and Minor Thesis

The Australasian pulp and paper industry have committed to the long-term development of the industry by providing sponsored places for talented graduates in science or engineering to study pulp and paper technology at the Australian Pulp and Paper Institute (APPI), Department of Chemical Engineering, Monash University. These sponsored places provide a \$18,000 (tax free) Scholarship over one year to Australian and New Zealand permanent residents only.

The Master of Eng. Sc. in Pulp & Paper Technology degree is a one year full-time course followed by a minor thesis course intake is 2007. The thesis project may be undertaken at APPI or one of the paper companies. Graduates from this course have had a high success rate in gaining work within the industry.

Successful applicants will:

- Be highly motivated, with demonstrated capacity to produce high quality results
- Have well developed communication and interpersonal skills
- Be able to develop innovative solutions for complex problems
- Have an honours degree or equivalent in science or engineering
